THE TERMS OF THE WARRANTY

Your Maxum watch is guaranteed for a period (2 years for all Digital and Ana-Digital Watches and 5 years for all Analogue Watches) from the date of purchase against all defects in material or workmanship. This does not apply to normal wear and tear or abuse of components and watch finish or plating (see "WATCH CARE AND PRECAUTIONS") and does not cover water damage caused by non-compliance with the water resistancy usage guide in the Maxum Operations Manual found at maxum.com.au

The following applies to Australian Purchases ONLY:

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or a refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure (the Mandatory Provision).

The following parts **ARE** covered by the Maxum limited warranty:

2 YEAR Limited Warranty (Digital and Ana-Digital Watches):

- Batteries - 1 YEAR
- Movement - 2 YEARS

5 YEAR Warranty (Analogue Watches):

- Batteries - 1 YEAR
- Movement - 5 YEARS

The following parts **ARE NOT** covered by the Maxum 2 Year or 5 Year limited warranty:

1. Band, strap or clasp
2. Case, hands, dial or lens damage, scratches or breakage
3. Water leakage if the screw-in-crown is not activated or the water resistancy guidelines have not been followed.
4. General wear and tear, finish or plating of the watch or any defects

arising from misuse or any other use which is not in accordance with the Recommended Watch care and Precautions.

In addition, this warranty does not cover issues from any alteration, service or repair performed by any party other than the Designa Accessories authorised service centre.

For this warranty to be valid, it must be dated at the time of purchase and stamped by the retailer. Any other warranty given by your retailer is entirely under their responsibility and the terms of this warranty cannot be changed by any person.

Note: Please refer to the "WATER RESISTANCY USAGE GUIDE" on reverse for information on the water resistancy of your watch.

RECOMMENDED WATCH CARE AND PRECAUTIONS

This watch contains precision electronic components and in some watches, fragile finishes. To ensure the best wear, please follow these simple guidelines for watch care;

1. Avoid leaving your watch in any extremes for long periods of time: direct sunlight, extremely warm or cold locations.
2. Avoid wet conditions unless your watch is suited for them. Never operate the buttons or crown when the watch is submerged in water.
3. Light activities will not affect your watch, but dropping or hitting against a hard surface will cause damage not only to the lens, case and band, but to internal components.
4. Do not expose the watch to solvents, mercury, cosmetic spray (e.g. hairspray, perfume, tanning solution, etc.), detergents, adhesives, paints, gases or other chemicals. They may cause discolouration and deterioration to the finish of the watch.
5. Do not under any circumstances wear your watch in a hot tub, sauna, shower or bath. The combination of extreme heat and water may cause your watch to lose its water resistancy.
6. Ensure that watches marked as water resistant are thoroughly rinsed in fresh water after use in salt and/or chlorinated water and dried with a soft cloth.
7. The watch and bracelet/band may collect dust and perspiration and will become soiled if not cleaned regularly. This is particularly the case with the inner parts of the links or mesh of the bracelet. Wipe periodically with a soft dry cloth.
8. No backward hand or date adjustments should be made when the analogue hands read between 8pm and 3am. At these times, the gears are too close together and such a change could cause damage. e.g. Daylight Savings time.
9. Avoid fastening the bracelet too tightly. You should be able to insert a finger between the band and your wrist (to make sure the wrist is at normal temperature and not overheated).

* No caseback marking indicates watch is dust resistant only & the wearer must not get watch wet.

** Water resistant casing does not permit pusher or button operation while in water.

GUIDELINES FOR HANDLING OF WATER RESISTANT WATCHES

- Water resistancy of your watch is greatly affected by the way the watch is treated - misuse will diminish water resistancy by affecting the case and lens seals.
- Although the watch is warrantied to the specifications marked, all care should be taken to avoid damage that results from mishandling.
- Should your watch have a screw-down crown, you must ensure that the screw lock crown is completely tightened at all times.
- If the watch comes in contact with salt or chlorinated water, be sure to rinse it thoroughly in warm fresh water afterwards.
- If a watch is wet, do not store it in a closed container. It should be dried out immediately to avoid damage to internal components.
- Should water or condensation appear in the watch, immediately have it serviced by those listed on your warranty as water can corrode components.
- Pressure in bar (ATM) is a test pressure. This measurement should not be considered as actual immersion depth. Various conditions i.e. beach surf may cause false pressure conditions. The dial marking indicated (ATM, M or BAR) represents the tested pressure.
